



ALL IN 7 WEEK SERIES

ALL IN is a dynamic 7-week series that will be split up throughout the year designed to help children grow into wholehearted followers of Jesus. This curriculum is built on key foundations that is Jesus-centered, and gospel-focused to help children strengthen their faith and encourage them to live out their faith daily, grow in character, and develop a personal relationship with Jesus, by shining His light in the world. Through engaging Bible stories, meaningful discussion, and practical application, ALL IN invites children to move beyond surface-level faith and step confidently into a life fully committed to Jesus.

Hook for Children: Life can be amazing, but it can also be tough. Some days your friends might hurt your feelings, school can feel hard, and sometimes it feels like no one really understands you. But guess what? You don't have to face any of it alone. This year, we're going ALL IN for Jesus! We're not talking about halfway faith or just trying harder—we're learning how to trust Jesus with our whole hearts, every single day! When things get tricky, and when life feels big, Jesus is right there with us. He gives us courage, helps us love others, and shows us how to live boldly for Him. We'll discover how being ALL IN with Jesus changes everything!

1st February: Not Lukewarm

- Bible Story: "Jesus warns the church about being Lukewarm" - Revelation 3:14-22
- Gospel Connection: Jesus gave everything for us on the cross, so we respond by loving Him with our whole hearts, not halfway.

8th February: Prioritising Jesus

- Bible Story: "Mary and Martha" - Luke 10:38-42
- Gospel Connection: Because Jesus put us first by giving His life, we can put Him first in our lives.

15th February: Love and Sacrifice

- Bible Story: "Love in Action" - John 15:13
- Main Idea: By trusting in Jesus, I can get a fresh start.
- Gospel Connection: Jesus showed the greatest love by sacrificing Himself for us, and His love helps us love others.

22nd February: Courage and Commitment

- Bible Story: "Daniel in the Lion's Den" - Daniel 6
- Gospel Connection: Jesus faced the cross with courage for us, so we can stand strong in our faith.



4-Week Children's Ministry Curriculum

EASTER PARTY 4 WEEK SERIES

This upcoming four-week Easter series, helps children understand why we celebrate Easter by exploring key events from Jesus' final week through to His resurrection. Across the month we journey with Jesus through the Triumphal Entry, The Last Supper, Jesus' death on the cross, and finally the joy of His resurrection. Even the darkest days shows God's amazing love in action, turning sadness into hope. His resurrection is the ultimate reason to jump, cheer and celebrate the amazing promises of God's love.

Hook for Children: What if you could throw the biggest celebration ever? A party filled with cheering, favourite foods, awesome prizes, and the best news you've ever heard? That's exactly what Easter is all about! Jesus walked into a crowd like a hero, shared a special meal with His friends, gave His life for us, and then—SURPRISE!—He came back alive! Get ready to discover why Easter is the biggest, happiest party in history!

8th March: Guest of Honour!

- Bible Story: "Jesus' Triumphant Entry" - Luke 19:28-40
- Gospel Connection: Just as Jesus predicted His death and resurrection to fulfill God's plan, we can trust Him to lead us into eternal life and new beginnings. His resurrection proves that He holds the power over life and death.

15th March: Let's Eat

- Bible Story: "The Last Supper" - Luke 22:7-23
- Gospel Connection: At the Last Supper, Jesus established communion, inviting us to partake in His sacrifice, which brings forgiveness and new life. This act of sharing bread and wine is a continual reminder of His love and the new covenant in His blood.

22nd March: Everyone's Invited

- Bible Story: "Jesus' Death on the Cross" - Luke 23:32-43
- Gospel Connection: Jesus chose to die on the cross because of His great love for us. He took the punishment for our sin so we could be forgiven and made right with God. The cross reminds us that no matter what we've done, Jesus' love is bigger and His grace is enough.

29th March: Celebrate

- Bible Story: "The Resurrection" - Luke 24:1-12
- Gospel Connection: Jesus appearing after His resurrection shows that He is alive and continues to meet us in our lives today. His victory over death is our assurance of eternal life, offering us everlasting joy and fellowship with Him.

1st March: Who Made Me, and Why?

- This lesson encourages children to explore concepts and big questions of life, focusing with a biblical lens as they engage in rich discussions to discover and understand the world around them
