WE ARE PEOPLE OF THE GOSPEL

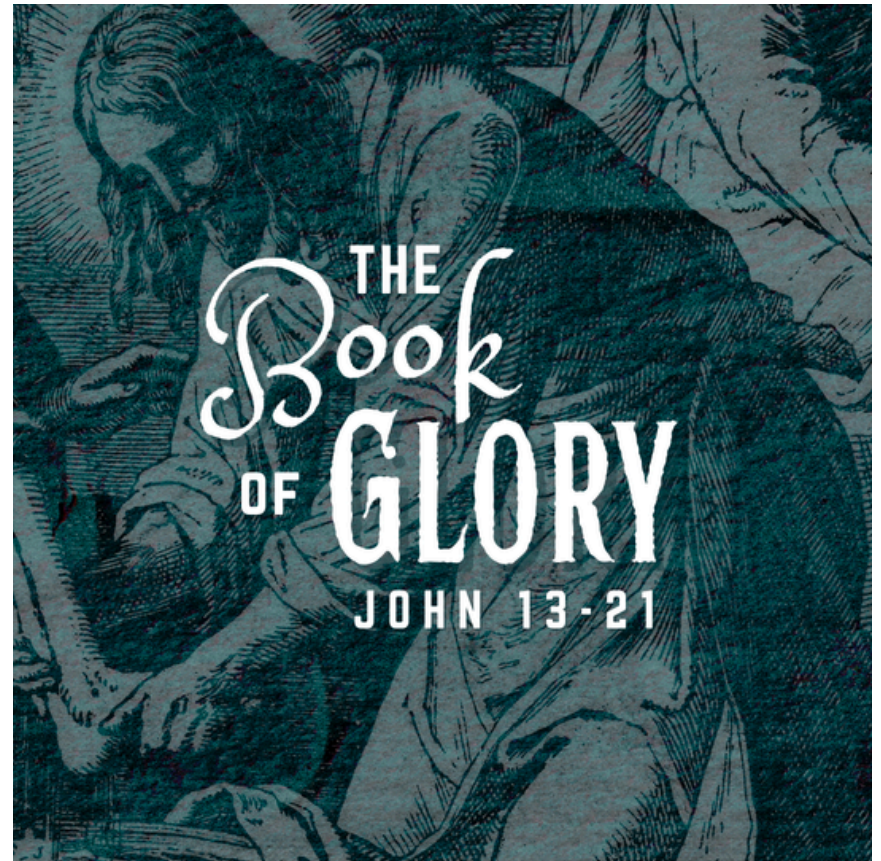
We are people who were once far off,
