Defeating 7 Deadly Sins

Think Lent. Traditionally, the season of Lent is a time of special devotion, self-denial, and humble repentance born of a faithful heart that dwells confidently on Christ's Word and draws from it life and hope. During Lent, many people put forth greater efforts in their spiritual disciplines to draw closer to Christ in their faith and character. Some give up certain earthly comforts or strive against certain sins to help them remember what Christ gave up for our salvation. This year for Lent, I encourage you to put forth extra effort to defeat seven different sins that have ruined the lives of many. Numerous people have fallen into the traps of these sins and become prisoners to their bonds.

Historically, the Catholic Church called these "the Seven Deadly Sins." From a Lutheran (Protestant) perspective, all sins are deadly. Any and all of our sins break fellowship with the Holy and Almighty God. Before the Lord, the variety of our sins have no hierarchy of "badness." They are all rebellions against Him. In this way, the seven deadly sins (**pride, envy, greed, wrath, sloth, gluttony, and lust**) are seen less as distinct categories of severity but as more useful descriptions of how sin manifests itself in our human lives. Early Lutheran theologians such as Martin Chemnitz urged pastors to teach and warn their people of these specific sins, encouraging believers to actively restrain against their tendencies and not succumb to their grip.

So how do we defeat these sins? On our own and by the sheer force of our human will and determination, we can't. But God can – and, by

grace through faith in Jesus Christ, empowered by the Holy Spirit – we can. The way of the Christian is daily dying and rising with repentance and faith in Christ.

Sin is real. Sin is serious. Sin is deadly. Sin is not something we can fix on our own. It continually throws us off, trips us up, traps us, and holds on to us. *"But God demonstrates His own love for us in this, while we were still sinners, Christ died for us."* (Rom. 5:8) This is Good News! God rescues us from these sins and, even more, He gives us His Spirit to have power over these sins in our lives. *"The Law of the Spirit of Life sets us free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death."* (Rom 8:2)

With faith in Christ Jesus, our sinful nature is crucified and a new person rises within us, empowered by God's Spirit to live for God and follow in His ways. (see Rom. 6:6 and Gal. 2:20) While in these mortal bodies, we will continue to sin. (see Rom. 7) But God's Spirit helps us overcome sins in daily life and sin less, walking in the ways God intends for us. (see Rom. 8) In the Resurrection, we will receive immortal bodies and be totally free from our sinful natures. For now, we live in daily repentance, remembering our Baptisms to drown the old Adam in us and live the new life God intends for us. In Christ, we can do this. We can enjoy successes in defeating sins. Thank You, Jesus! This is our challenge for Lent 2026, defeating seven deadly sins.

Seven Deadly Sins (from a traditional list, viewed through a Lutheran lens):

Feb. 22 Pride (superbia): The ultimate sin; trusting in self, not God.

Mar. 1 Envy (invidia): Resentment of another's good fortune.

Mar. 8 Greed (avaritia): Excessive desire for material wealth, making idols of earthly things.

Mar. 15 Wrath (ira): Uncontrolled anger, leading to violence or destruction.

Mar. 22 Gluttony (gula): Excessive indulgence in food or drink, using things for destruction rather than enjoyment. Lust (luxuria): Uncontrolled sexual desire, distorting God's gift of sexuality.

Mar. 29 Sloth (acedia): Spiritual laziness or apathy towards God and His gifts, distinct from mere physical laziness.

As Lutheran Christians, we use this list to understand the depths of human sinfulness, rejoice in Christ's redeeming sacrifice, and focus on God's grace and the power of His Spirit within us to avoid the disastrous pitfalls of these perilous sins in our lives.



Personal Mission Statements

What is a Personal Mission Statement? A Personal Mission Statement is a short, memorable, and easy to recall sentence that helps provide direction, guidance, and purpose in all areas of life. Personal mission statements help answer the question: Do my actions honor God as the unique person He made me to be? Personal mission statements help us figure out to what things we should say YES! And, by the way, they also help us figure out to what things we might need to say NO!

Simply put: Personal mission statements are unique reflections of who God has made us to be. They put God's purposes into words that we can carry with us.
