

Feeling stuck and going through the motions.


#### **JEREMIAH 9**

<sup>4</sup> Then the word of the Lord came to him: "This man will not be your heir, but a son who is your own flesh and blood will be your heir."



12 And God said, "I will be with you."




<sup>1</sup> Moses answered, "What if they do not believe me or listen to me?"


10 Moses said to the Lord,

Then you will be prosperous and successful.
