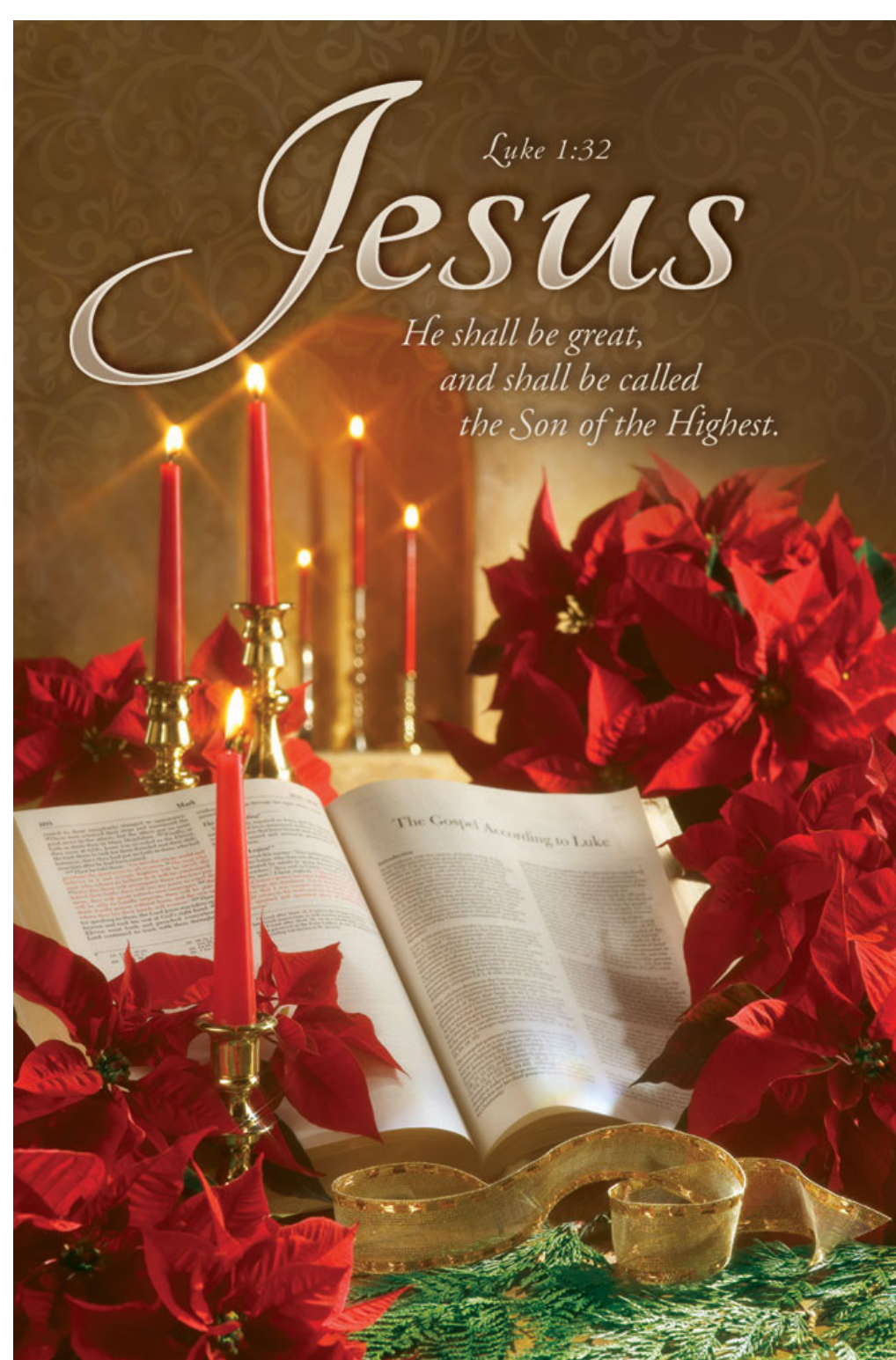
JOY TO THE WORLD! THE LORD IS COME
