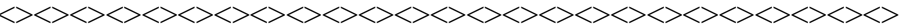

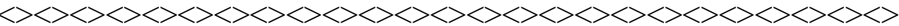

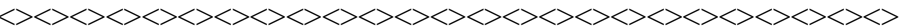



Hymn of Commitment

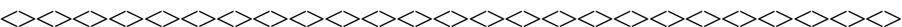
