



In his letter to the church in Corinth, the apostle Paul writes “whoever sows bountifully will also reap bountifully” (2 Cor. 9:6-8). Just as Paul gives thanks for the abundant generosity in that church, we also give thanks to God for the bountiful giving to All Saints over this past year. Through generous tithes and offerings, and by God’s grace, our church body in Austin, and our missional partners here and around the world, were equipped and formed in order to continue to sow seeds of God’s goodness. Here are some ways in which these bountiful gifts were felt in 2025:

- Welcomed an average of 1,182 people to worship together each Sunday (including children’s discipleship in Small Saints during all three services).
- Contributed \$528,500 to partners beyond All Saints, including:
 - 14 local and national missional partners.
 - 14 international missional partners across 9 different countries.
 - Resurrection Presbyterian Church, a northwest Austin church plant launched in 2024.
 - Reach South Texas, our church planting partner, whose goal is to plant one church every year.
 - Seminary support through grants and scholarships to ensure that our robust theological tradition can grow.
- Developed ministries of benevolence and care through our 39 deacons and deaconesses.
- Continued to grow our Summer Fellows program with 16 participants.
- Engaged with the men and women of the church through weekday Bible Studies.
 - 270 or more women met on Wednesday mornings and evenings.
 - 35 or more men met on Wednesday mornings.
- Supported 27 [Formation Groups](#) so that our growing church community can find deeper connections with peers and neighbors. (If you are not connected and would like to be,

- Launched Divorce Care, Raising Saints, and 50+ Crossroads to better meet the needs of our growing congregation.
- Marked one year since breaking ground on our new Sanctuary Project. (You can check out the progress [here](#)).
- Hosted retreats and camps including:
 - VBS for 228 children
 - Catechism Camp for 18 children
 - Men's Silent Retreat for 30 men
 - Women's Silent Retreat for 28 women
 - Young Adult Retreat for 23 participants
 - Our annual, community hospitality events through the Missions Conference and Sandra McCracken Concert.
- Celebrated 85 baptisms, including 51 covenant children and 34 adults.

We are so thankful for the support in what God is doing in and through our church, enabling us to be the Body of Christ in Austin for the world.
