- 1. Review from last week... Describe what a Christian looks like.
- 2. Read Luke 6:40 Describe a disciple of Christ...

Disciple = learner-pupil-apprentice-adherent-follower

3. Discuss Journey's mission statemen...

To make disciples of Jesus who love God, love people and serve the world.

- 4. Discuss the following statement by Pastor John...**People who were nothing like Jesus, liked Jesus.** Here's why...*He [Jesus] canceled the record of the charges against us and took it away by nailing it to the cross.* (Colossians 2:14 NLT)
- 5. Karen Armstrong said..."Yet against all odds, by the third century, Christianity had become a force to be reckoned with. We still do not really understand how this came about." Why do you think that Christianity became a force to be reckoned with?
- 6. "And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church and the gates of Hades will not overcome it. I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven." Then he ordered his disciples not to tell anyone that he was the Messiah. (Matthew 16:18-20)

Question: What is Jesus talking about in this passage?

Question: What is this Rock?

Question: How has the kingdom of heaven affected you?

7. Discuss the following statement by Pastor John "Jesus wasn't talking about a place people would come to. Jesus was promising a people that would go out. He was talking about a *body*—a body of people who would be committed to this one big idea: that Jesus is the Christ, the Savior, the Messiah, the Lord of all, the Son of the living God.

Question: How this one big idea of who Jesus is changed your life and changed the life of other people you know?

8. ...He has risen just as He said... (Matthew 28:6)

Question: How has your belief in the resurrection affected your belief in Jesus?

9. Question: What kind of church is Journey?
