

Knowing God Blesses His Children

“Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.

These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. Impress them on your children...”

Deuteronomy 6:4-7

Knowing God, loving God alone, keeping the decrees of God and not serving other gods – reading through Deuteronomy can be a bit overwhelming, with the weight of what feels like works-based righteousness. Moses is so repetitive in his exhortations and themes. Yet, chapter 6 shines as a light for the reasoning for the repetition. Read verses 1-9. The teaching and direction is for the people’s own good and the good for their children as the ideal purpose of who they are. Total love of God is the ideal. Why? It is for everyone’s own good. There is no better place to be than centering one’s life around what God wants for us, His teachings, because they show us the path of blessing and deep joy in knowing the Father.

As Jesus is the full revelation of God’s merciful grace in our lives, God’s commands for His people are interjected with His merciful grace that is tied together with his teachings (see Dt 6:20-25). In Jesus, God’s glorious mercy takes our sin, placing it on Jesus as the atonement for our inability to love God completely as commanded in Deuteronomy 6:5. Jesus kept the law, and taught us to follow the ideal purpose of God (Matt 22:37). And He completed this purpose by becoming the righteousness of God for us (Rom 3:19-26)! The triune God (Father, Son and Holy Spirit) blesses us mercifully to experience the blessed experience of living in His favor – to be loved by God and to love Him with everything we are!

Share this with your children. Love the Lord your God with everything you are and let it be known! God loves you and sent His Son so you may know His mercy and grace that you may live into His ideal purpose of your life.
