

As Kim later learned—and as all of us who receive Jesus as our Savior come to know—though our earthly parents and others will disappoint us, we have a heavenly Father who loves us and won’t let us down. John—the author of three inspired biblical letters, the gospel bearing his name, and the book of Revelation—understood the depth of God’s love. In fact, he referred to himself as “the disciple whom Jesus loved” ([John 21:20](#)), identifying himself as someone whose life had been changed by Christ’s love for him. “See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!” he wrote ([1 John 3:1](#)).

God loves us so much that He gave His Son Jesus, who laid down His life for us (v. 16; [John 3:16](#)). He's always available to us in prayer, and He promises, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you" ([Hebrews 13:5](#)). We can rest secure in His love.

**LOVE** is patient, love is kind.  
does not envy.  
is never boastful, nor conceited, nor rude;  
is not self-seeking, nor easily angered.  
keeps no record of wrongdoing.  
does not delight in evil,  
But rejoices in the truth.  
always protects, trusts, hopes, and preserves.  
There is nothing love cannot face;  
There is no limit to its faith, hope, and endurance.  
In a word, there are three things that last forever:  
Faith, hope, and love;  
But the greatest of them all is **LOVE**.
