

Accessing Files from the AJW Flash Drive on Your Android Device

Step 1: Remove Your Phone Case (If Needed)

If your case blocks the USB-C port or causes a loose connection, remove it before plugging in the flash drive.

Step 2: Plug in the AJW Flash Drive

Insert the flash drive into your Android phone's USB-C port.

Step 3: Open the “My Files” or “Files” App

Most Android phones come with a built-in file manager. Open My Files, Files, or File Manager, depending on your device brand.

If your phone doesn't have a built-in file manager, you can download one for free from the Google Play Store—such as Files by Google.

Step 4: Tap “USB Storage” or “External Drive”

You should see a new option under storage sources—often labeled USB Drive, USB Storage, or by the flash drive's brand name.

Step 5: Browse and Play Your Files

Tap any file to open or play it. Audio, video, and PDF files will open in the default app on your device.

Troubleshooting Tips:

- If nothing shows up, unplug and reconnect the flash drive.
- Make sure your phone supports USB OTG (most modern phones do).
- You may need to allow access when prompted.
