

PACKING LIST

There will be a chance to stop at Walmart or a similar store in McAllen before crossing the border at the beginning of the week, so if there's something you forget, don't stress!

- Passport and COVID-19 vaccination card
- Masks (we've found that the disposable masks are more comfortable in the heat!)
- Up-to-date Tetanus booster
- Old, comfortable clothes for the worksite (keep in mind, they will get dirty!)
- Work boots or sturdy lace-up tennis shoes for the worksite
- Backpack or other bag to keep your personal belongings with you on the worksite
- Water bottle
- Sunglasses, hat, bandanas
- Work gloves (3 pairs are recommended; leather or rubber work best)
- Back brace (if necessary)
- Sunscreen & insect repellent
- Comfortable, lightweight clothes for evenings; casual, "nice" outfit for church or end-of-week fiesta (optional)
- Sandals or flip-flops for evenings; plastic flip-flops or something similar for shower shoes
- Toiletries (shampoo, conditioner, body wash, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
- Twin-sized bed sheets, pillowcase, blanket (optional); towel, washcloth
- Medications (if necessary; they should be in original bottles/packaging)
- Bible, notebook/journal, pen
- Spending money (small bills recommended; no need to exchange to pesos)
- First aid kit (check with your team leader, as there may be a team first aid kit)
- Optional items: favorite snack food, air mattress, cards/small games, small fan, extension cord, Bluetooth speakers, camera/battery/charger, earplugs, etc.)
- Patience, flexibility, humor!
