Living A Rightly Ordered Life | Part 6: Everything You Need

BIG Idea: God never commands what He has not already provided.

Application: Walk confidently in obedience, trusting that God has already supplied everything you need for life and godliness.

Discussion Questions

Icebreaker: When was a time you felt unprepared for something important — but later realized you had more than you thought?

1. In 2 Peter 1:3, what stands out to you about the phrase “everything we need”?
2. Why do you think Peter emphasizes “divine power” before mentioning effort?
3. How does knowing the power at work in you is resurrection power (Ephesians 1:19–20) change the way you view obedience?
4. Why do you think God sometimes commands obedience before visible provision appears?
5. What is the difference between earning salvation and growing in response to grace?
6. Which part of Peter’s growth progression (faith, moral excellence, knowledge, etc.) feels most relevant to you right now?
7. Where in your life might you be excusing disobedience as inadequacy?
8. What fears most often make you feel like you “don’t have what it takes”?
9. How can we as a group help one another move from knowing provision is given to actually walking in it?
10. What is one specific area this week where you sense God inviting you to step forward in faith?

Prayer Prompt: Pray that God would open your eyes to see the provision already given, strengthen your confidence in His power, and give you courage to take your next obedient step.
