

President's Message

Revisions for May Boulevard Church on January 28 RHCA Meeting Agenda

As a result of discussions at the December meeting of the Lee District Land Use Advisory Committee, the issue of the proposed May Boulevard church will be back on the RHCA agenda for its January 28 meeting at 7:30 p.m. in the community room of the John Marshall Library. The applicant has proposed some new conditions in an effort to gain the support of both RHCA and the Land Use Advisory Committee. The latter is an ad hoc group made up of representatives of citizen and homeowner associations in Lee District. Its decision is supported by both the Lee District member of the Planning Commission and the Board of Supervisors. As a result, RHCA has been asked by the Land Use Committee to reevaluate its rejection of the proposal based on the new conditions.

The County staff will issue an addendum to its previously published approval of the proposal as a result of the applicant's revised conditions and RHCA's points of opposition raised in a series of meetings over the last few months. Basically, RHCA is opposed to increasing the intensity of the site because it is located in the midst of a quiet residential neighborhood. It should be noted that

the current use has been operation for more than three decades. It originally was the site of the Rose Hill Community Center, which operated from the 1950s until the late 1970 before closing because of financial issues.

The applicant has proposed a reduction of seats in the church as well as increased parking on the site. Both the church, existing child care center and school of general education will have a total of 400 worshipers and students, although in separate sessions. Rose Hill Academy operates Monday through Friday from approximately 6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. The church proposes services on Sundays with smaller activities on Saturday and some week nights. The day care caters to elementary school age youngsters who are transported by bus to nearby schools.

The owner of the property plans to reserve a portion of the site in order to build six houses under the R-3 zoning classification recommended in the comprehensive plan. All of Rose Hill is zoned R-3. Should the entire property develop at R-3, both RHCA and the Franconia Museum are on record as supporting the retention of the existing silos on the property as living examples of Franconia's agricultural history. The Rose Hill property has a rich history and operated as a farm from the mid-1700s to the 1950s. Silos were invented in the early 1900s and the ones at Rose Hill have been there since the early 1940s.

which to live in Virginia. Even more important, Rose Hill came in first in the category of public safety. The blog provides information to the real estate industry and potential buyers. Among Fairfax County areas overall, Tysons Corner ranked second, Annandale fourth and Rose Hill ninth. The results were provided recently by the Rose Hill-Kingstowne Patch, our hometown newsletter on the Internet. Our lofty ranking is the product of the Fairfax County Police, our Neighborhood Watch program and other safety conscious neighbors. Rose Hill has a large contingent of citizens who keep watch over their neighborhoods for potential vandalism, thefts and other criminal activity. They and others also watch out for zoning and other violations that detract from our community. Those issues include rundown properties, overcrowding, illegal modifications and additions and the parking of inoperable, unlicensed or large commercial vehicles. Rose Hill is part of a residential parking district that regulates the type and location of vehicles on our public streets and property. Lest we become complacent, police recently report that a shotgun was stolen from a vehicle and there was a car broken into. Both occurred on a quiet residential street in Rose Hill. Also, a car was stolen near the shopping center. Please keep an eye out for suspicious or illegal activity. If you see something, SAY SOMETHING. For criminal activity in progress, call 911. The police non-emergency number is 703-691-2131. For property issues or illegal parking on private property, use this number to report illegal activity such as illegal parking on the street. If you see overcrowding, illegal additions or rundown property, call the Zoning Enforcement office at 703-324-1300. If you are uncomfortable making a report or feel your concerns are not being addressed, call or e-mail any of the RHCA officers.

2013 Holiday Lights Winners

Two addresses have moved up to the Grand Prize category over the recent holiday season. Both are unique in that they feature simple but eye-catching displays. The Grigsbys at 6409 Willowood Lane combined back lighting with large stars with

Give us a call before New Year's Day 2015 and let us know what category in which you think they deserve mention. Sometimes, the displays are not lighted at the time the overall judges make their rounds, so your help with help ensure no one is missed.

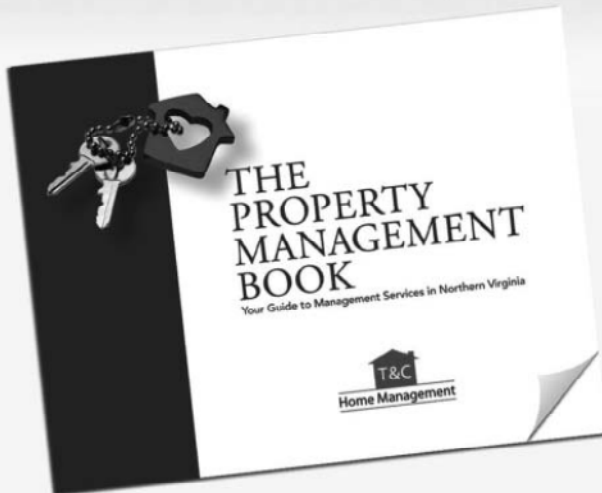

This exposes the roof decking (the sub-structure that literally, "keeps you out of the rain") to moisture which slowly deteriorates and rots the wood beneath, leading to leaks and more extensive damage.

Further, the metal flashings around chimney areas and at adjoining exterior walls (or rooflines), the penetration collars (around plumbing and heat stacks) and all other vents become worn and prone to water infiltration.

Next time you're outside, take a close look at your roof (most people don't pay attention to it until there's a problem). How does it look? Is it rough and weathered? Are the shingles "curling" or cracking? Is one section very distinguishable from all other areas? Finally, are you proud of the way your roof helps "show" your home, or are you embarrassed by its appearance?

Remember: By the time you have waited "as long as possible," you have probably waited too long and will end up spending your hard earned money on interior and sub-structure repairs, as well as a much needed roof replacement.
