The Rose Hill Civic Association will sponsor two important events this summer, beginning with the Fish Fry on Tuesday, June 26th in the Nichols' front yard at 6416 Rose Hill Drive. Serving begins at 6 p.m. If you can help set up, fry fish or cook hot dogs, the work will begin at 4p.m. The annual Night Out honoring our First Responders will be held on Tuesday, August 7th, same time, same place.

Raccoon Attack

Mimi Minarick reports her cat was attacked by a raccoon on the patio at her home, 6518 Telegraph Road on the afternoon of May 29. Mimi was able to chase away the raccoon with the help of wasp spray, but the injured cat ran off. Mimi found her cat two days later in the back yard of a house about a block away on Telegraph Road and took him to the vet. However, the animal was injured too badly and would not recover, according to the vet. The cat was euthanized and Fairfax County Animal Control was notified of the attack. The raccoon is still at large. Residents are warned to keep cats and other small animals close at hand as raccoons and other predators also make Rose Hill their home. Warn children not to approach raccoons as they may have rabies.

New Neighbors on Telegraph Road

The United States Department of State intends to occupy the vacant office building at 6801 Telegraph Road across from Greendale Golf Course. The State Department will use the property to house its high security tenants (Diplomatic Security). The General Services Agency will handle design and construction activities. The proposed renovation will consist of modernizing the interior, creating new office spaces and training laboratories, repairing the existing complex as well as security arrangements and environmental remediation projects. Funding has **not** yet been approved.

Last year, RHCA asked Congressman Beyer's office for information concerning proposed use of the vacant building. Supervisor McKay's office also asked for the update. On May 28, 2018, the State Department sent a letter recommitting to the project and confirmed justification to use Federal government property for long-term purposes.

The Department of State set a target date of 2022 for finalizing space requirement and completing all related work for occupancy. The design will be coordinated with the Virginia State Preservation Office and is subject to review by the National Capital Park and Planning Commission. No local approval is involved, although it is expected that GSA will coordinate plans with Fairfax County.

Upon receiving the information, Supervisor McKay's office's office immediately notified RHCA, which had

repeatedly expressed concerns about the future use of the property. At the same time, it was revealed that the project team would coordinate security requirements with the Fairfax County Park Authority for access along the Telegraph Road perimeter to construct a multi-use trail.

The building has been vacant since 2015. Constructed by the Army in 1958, it previously housed the Air Force Technical Applications Center and the Defense Nuclear Agency. Its neighbor to the south is an Army Reserve Center. The trail will connect Lee District Park to Huntley Meadows Park along Telegraph Road.

RHCA will be interested to see what, if any, road improvements will be part of the project. Rush hour traffic has increased considerable because of new facilities at Fort Belvoir, so accommodations for access to the Telegraph Road site will need to be addressed.

Rose Hill Beauty Update

Rain and lack of interest have slowed the Rose Hill Beauty process for 2018. The rain ruined most of the May flowers. There has been only one property nominated by a neighbor. Rock Road in a house Lois and her son, Steve, owned. Steve passed away suddenly several years ago.

Special Story: Return to Rose Hill...

Since her daughter, Anna, was coming to Baltimore for a conference in her role as a librarian, Linda McMurray Duer decided to come along to visit her father's grave at Arlington National Cemetery. Helped along by prodding from Anna, she also decided to try to find the home she left in 1958. She remembered living on Rose Hill Drive and riding her bike with her best friend, Libby, who lived nearby.

Duer had lots of pictures of her growing up in Rose Hill, many clearly showing the house number, 4207 Rose Hill Drive. Unfortunately, Fairfax County changed all the house numbers in the early 1960s, so she wasn't sure which one was her childhood home. The picture of Duer and her friend Libby riding bikes way back when provided the clue. Linda said the picture was taken in front of her house. Behind her in the picture is the old farm house that existed on Bee Street before the new houses there were built. The house across the street in the immediate background is the only one of two on Rose Hill Drive that sits at an angle. The other one faces it across the street.

It became clear that the house where Linda McMurray lived in the late 1950s now was 6416 Rose Hill Drive and owned by David and Linda Nichols, who have lived there since 1974. And Linda Nichols remembered Linda McMurray's friend, Libby, as Elizabeth Anderson, who lived across the street on Hayfield Place. Linda Nichols pulled out her 1971 Edison High School yearbook and Duer identified Libby as one of the graduates pictured. She and Libby haven't seen each other since they both were 21 years old. RHCA now will turn to the Franconia Museum to see if Libby Anderson can be found.

Mary Smith, who lives nearby and is a member of the Board of Directors of the Franconia Museum, identified the old farm house shown in the picture as the one that was demolished when Bee Street was established. Smith said the surveyors ran into a swarm of bees when they first arrived, so the street name was a good fit. Ironically, David Nichols had two aunts who lived on Rock-A-By Road, immediately behind the farm house. Mary Smith recalled that that street got its name because all of the women who lived there were pregnant at the time the County was naming streets. Smith has lived in Franconia all her life, moving to Rose Hill in 1970. Her dad was the first paid fireman at the Franconia Volunteer Fire Department and her mother taught at Franconia School.

Linda McMurray Duer and Anna visited Rose Hill on Thursday, June 14, 2018. They made contact with RHCA through myrosehill.com. Carl Sell and Linda Nichols invited the Duers to visit Linda at her home, not realizing that it would turn

out to be the house the visitors were trying to find. The longer everyone compared old pictures with today's landscapes, the more apparent it became that the search ended right where they were standing. Later on, Connie Beatty interrupted her busy schedule and stopped by to put her seal of approval on what the group had decided. After all, Mrs. Beatty moved to Rose Hill in December 1954 and therefore is the recognized authority on community history.

Linda McMurray moved with her mother, Penny, younger brother, David, and older brother, Randy, to Coldwater, Kansas in 1958 after her parents, Cecil (Mac) McMurray and Hazel Pennington McMurray, were divorced. Linda McMurray Duer now is a CPA in San Clemente, California. Her daughter lives near Los Angeles. Mac McMurray was a member of the Army signal corps in World War II and later operated the radar at National Airport.
