#### Thanks to Rose Hill Apartments

As often happens, the new contractor who cuts the grass at the Rose Hill Apartments did not get the word about the unique arrangement between the management and RHCA that results in the cutting of the grass in the Rose Hill Drive median between Rose Hill Elementary and Franconia Road. The situation was quickly remedied and grass was cut even before a complaint could be fully registered. The median belongs to the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), which has the responsibility to keep the grass mowed. However, budgets being what they are, VDOT does not have the funds to keep the median cut regularly. Enter the apartments, owned by AJ. Dwoskin Companies. The apartment management responded to an RHCA request years ago and included the median on its regular mowing schedule. That is why the Rose Hill drive median always looks sharp. For its part, RHCA pays for quarterly plantings in front of the community sign at Rose Hill Drive and Franconia Road. The funds are raised through contributions from RHCA members. We are fortunate to

have a project in our midst that keeps its buildings and grounds in good shape. Now, if we could only get the same type of cooperation from the owners of the shopping center. We have asked the shopping center management to assist in picking up trash along Rose Hill Drive that borders the center. So far, no positive response. To be clear, we are talking about the shopping center management, not the individual store operators.

Condolences to the family of Marie Sherfey, long-time resident of Rose Hill Drive who passed away on April 30th. Marie moved to Rose Hill in 1965 and was active in RHCA and community affairs for many years. Until she became ill, she was a fixture walking on Rose Hill Drive. ### **Nearby Entertainment**

Rose Hill is fortunate to have nearby parks that provide relaxation, education and entertainment for residents of all ages. Lee District Park includes a large number of opportunities, highlighted by the FREE summer concert series. Starting June 20, and continuing every Wednesday until August 29, concerts are scheduled starting at 7:30 p.m. in the Amphitheater. On June 20, the Cathedral Brass group will entertain with symphonic brass, followed on June 27 by the Fabulous Hubcaps with their Oldies, Classic Rock and Soul offerings. On July 11, the Northern

Virginia Community College/Annandale Symphony Orchestra will perform its Summer Pops program. The City of Falls Church Concert Band will perform July 18, followed by Lindsey Lou and the Flatbellys American Roots concert on July 25. August will include the Pitetasters (Ska) on August 1, Sharon Clark Quarter (Jazz) on August 8, the Nighthawks (Blues) on August 15, the Junkyard Band (GoGo) on August 22 and the United States Navy Cruisers (Pop and Rock) to end the series on August 29. The series made possible by the support of Cox Communications, 495/95 Express Lanes, Dominion Energy, Erickson Living (Greenspring) and Sheehy Auto Stores. The performances last one hour. Bring a chair or blanket and enjoy these wonderful free concerts.

If you haven't yet discovered Lee District Park, or forgotten the old friend that is right across the street, check out the indoor pool and exercise opportunities at the Recreation Center, the fabulous water park with carousel, nature trails and picnic facilities.

And if that isn't enough, play a round of golf at Greendale Golf Course or take part in the many nature programs at spectacular Huntley Meadows Park. Visit the Historic Huntley house on Harrison Lane for the ice cream treat for children of all ages where you can help make your ice cream and eat it too! The event will be held at 2:30 p.m. on Sunday, July 8 and Saturday, August 28 at 11 a.m. The one-hour event costs \$8 per person.

Also, visit the Farmer's Market every Friday from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. in the Giant parking lot at Kingstowne. The market features local vendors serving fruits, vegetables, baked goods, plants, honey, flowers, meat, dairy and eggs. You might also like to visit the Nalls Farm Market on Beulah Street where you can shop with the chickens and geese and visit Penny the Pig. Nalls is open daily and is a constant reminder of Franconia's agricultural past.

### **More Backyard Clutter?**

As The Rambler went to press, the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors considered a zoning ordinance amendment that would enlarge the area of backyards in residential districts that can be approved for accessory structures. At present, the ordinance limits uses such as children's playhouses to 100 square feet. As proposed, the amendment would increase the maximum rear yard coverage area of minimum rear yard requirements in a residential district from 30 percent to 60 percent. The increase apparently would require a Special Permit from the Board of Zoning Appeals. I say apparently because zoning ordinance amendments are hard to understand. When it becomes clearer, we will let the community know. Here in Rose Hill, we have seen accessory uses turn into living quarters with electric wires running from the main house. Hopefully, the county will take that into consideration as it considers the permits. Anything that limits or interferes with the use of neighboring properties is not a good idea.
