Read John 18:28-40

Did anything stand out either from Justin's message or reading through John together?

Re-read verse 28. **Why did the Jewish leaders not enter Pilate's headquarters? Why is that ironic from the Jewish leaders?**

How does Jesus respond to the questions from Pilate? Why does He not directly answer the questions Pilate asks Him?

Have someone in the group read Luke 23:18-25. **What is happening in this scene? And how are we, as Christians, like Barabbas in this passage?**

If Jesus' kingdom is not of this world, how should that shape the way Christians engage with power, politics, and influence?

Pilate knows Jesus is innocent, yet still hands Him over. **What pressures in our lives make it tempting to compromise what we know is right?**

What are the "big questions" in life that Justin mentioned we all have to answer? (*What is truth? What happens after death? What is the best kind of life? What should I do with guilt and shame?*).

What are the "big questions" of life you have found yourself wrestling with lately, whether from that previous list or not? Why/how is Jesus the answer to that question?
