Jeremiah 31:33 - I will put my law in their minds

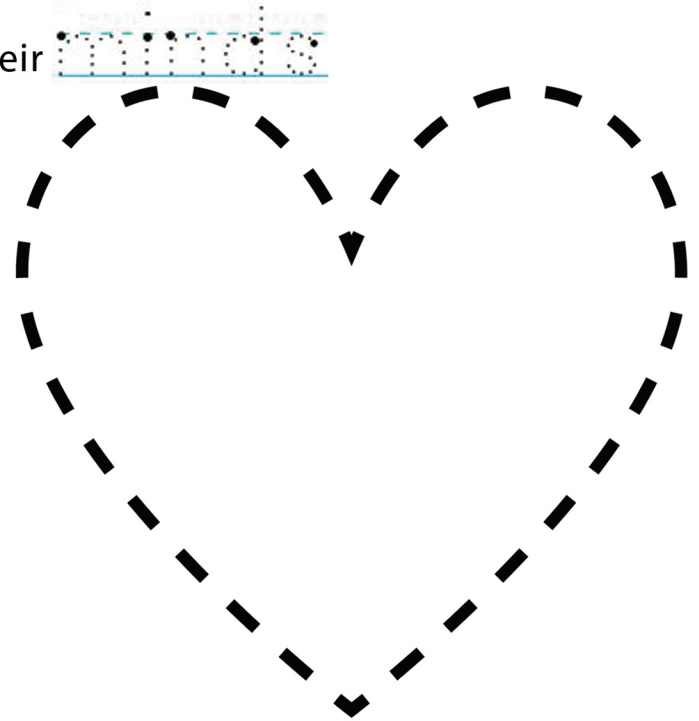
I will write it on their hearts
