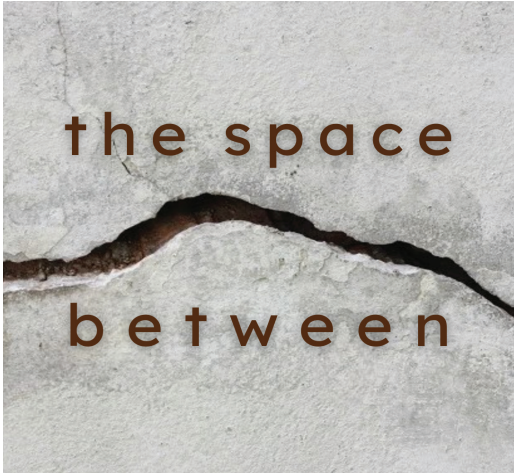

Sermon Series

The Space Between: Discovering God in an Either/Or World  
February 22 – April 5

Lent calls us into the wilderness—not to reduce our lives to easy answers, but to sit honestly with tension, ambiguity, and transformation. We live in an either/or world that insists on sides, binaries, and quick conclusions. Yet the Gospel of Luke reveals a different way: a faith shaped not by rigid opposites, but by the holy space between them.

We will journey with Jesus through moments where life refuses to be neatly divided—and real transformation takes place not at the extremes, but in the living, breathing tension of life and faith.

Today’s Questions

- Jesus shifts the question from “Who is my neighbor?” to “What kind of neighbor am I?” Where in your everyday life — at work, online, in your neighborhood, or in your family — do you feel challenged to move from judging or categorizing people to actually practicing neighborliness?
- The sermon suggests that grace and growth begins in the uncomfortable space between judgment and compassion. Can you think of a time when your first impression of someone changed once you really saw them? What helped you cross that space between stranger and neighbor?
