From The Pastor

This month our music ministries are focusing on, preparing for, and anticipating the celebration of Palm Sunday and Easter. Our sermon series focus also shifts in the gospel of John. John 12 begins with a narrative just 6 days before the observance of Passover, during which time our Lord will suffer, die, and be resurrected from the grave! Invite family and friends. Bring a neighbor to church as we look forward to Easter.

Since the first week in October, I have been praying with Jeff White about an opportunity to submit his resume for the position of National Director of Kenya for SIM. I reminded Jeff that when he left our church staff to go to Malawi as a missionary, he told me that with the Lord's gifting, as well as the excellent equipping he had received in our church, his desire was not only to serve as a missionary but also to ultimately serve the Lord as a director of missions over an entire country. During this week Jeff, Carson, and the kids are in Kenya looking at schools, housing, and other details needed before making their decision on SIM's offer. Obviously, this decision will be life-altering and will stretch Jeff and the family spiritually and circumstantially in many ways. Pray that Jeff and Carson feel no fear, doubt, or hesitancy if God calls them, or any obligation to accept an offer based on anything other than God's perfect will, timing, and next step for their lives. I know they covet and treasure our prayers, especially this week!

The Ostermann family will arrive in the U.S. in mid-February to begin the process of establishing a Sow Hope Farms ministry in the states (similar to Farming God's Way in Uganda). Please keep them in your prayers as they explore the option of adjusting their ministry to ministering 6 months each year between Uganda and the U.S. They would love to meet with you to visit about this and to catch you up on the many wonderful things God is doing in Uganda. Klint will be updating the church on Sunday, February 22.

I love our church! God's grace has blessed us in so many ways! May we be a people of great grace, faith, and obedience as we respond to His salvation and relationship!

Giving through text message is available! Text **FBCtxt** and the **amount** you want to give to **73256**. When you make your first contribution you will need to set up your account information, which will be saved, so that future contributions will be quick and easy. This option is available for general budget contributions only.

Online giving is available using your debit card. Go to faithwf.com and click on the online giving link. You will have the same options that are available on your offering envelope and will receive a receipt for your contribution.

Did you know that you can make your tithe and offering by using your bank's online bill pay? You can schedule your contribution check to be sent automatically to the church as a true first fruit of what the Lord has blessed you with. Just set Faith Baptist Church as a payee, enter "general budget" or your envelope number for the account number and 3001 Southwest Pkwy, Wichita Falls, TX 76308 as the address. You can then choose a regular monthly, twice monthly, or weekly schedule.

Monthly, we mail envelope packets with an envelope for each Sunday. If you give once a month and prefer to be on a list to be mailed 12 envelopes per year, please notify the Administration Office. You can email Sheryl Alexander at sheryla@faithwf.com, or call the Church Office. It takes a couple of months for our envelope mailing service to make the change. Thank you for helping us be good stewards.
