We love to share with what God is doing here in Uganda. This past week Charity was able to share teaching with the YWAM ladies about injustice and forgiveness. Through this teaching it brought up questions in regards to forgiveness and how you can forgive someone who continues hurting you every time. We saw the Holy Spirit show up and direct the conversation to bring healing and forgiveness and the women's lives. We saw God moving through our conversations with people in how to respond to them and point them to God.

We also had the opportunity to go to the refugee camp after 2 hours of driving on a bumpy road. We were able to encourage and distribute feminine hygiene items to the women. Life in the camp is very difficult and most people there are in a state of survival. They just cut the food rations and with little rain their gardens are dying. This is a huge need that we need to keep praying for how to help the people and their needs there. Even with all of this we see unity among the ladies and felt God's peace and love there.
