- This came from one of our gathering groups...
Last night, 7 French students and the 2 leaders (students and leaders from an exchange student program in our community) showed up to experience Yahuah! Her cousin was going to have kidney surgery, and we prayed for healing and wholeness to the kidney. What a glorious night! All praise and honor and glory be to our Living, healing, caring God, Yahuah! And that was just my group! We had 4 groups go out...
- Jim had come early to Encounter Night because he was our speaker that night. He was sharing testimonies from his life. He shared how the eye Dr. had found three arteries or veins in his eye that were kind of ballooned up and in danger of bursting or collapse. The doctor told him to come back in four months to check it. He had prayed about it. When he came back the doctor said they needed to check his eye again, especially because he was diabetic.
