He said to me "Look again at the Water..." I see the rough places, turbulence... this represents Sin, Heartache, Trials of all sorts... but there are also places of smooth shady water... places of refuge to rest & heal & reflect, like where I am now Lord.. thank You.

"Look again at the rough places... how do you know it's rough?" Because of how the light hits it... some of it quite bright. Then it hit me... I was missing the LIGHT. It was brightest and most brilliant where the water was roughest.
