Wow, that was helpful! The quality of the constructive feedback was exactly what we were hoping to receive. More details will be shared at a later date, but here is some general feedback. The plans for a larger Narthex and ADA compliance/ramp were overwhelmingly popular. Many were concerned about lighting and sound. Rest-assured that sound and lighting engineers will be involved during the design phase. We also have many helpful questions to research on other important topics. Moving forward, the Task Force will finish meticulously going through the individual surveys, meet with the architects later this month, and then, when they are ready, schedule another congregational feedback session.
