



2026 Father & Daughter Campout

Location: South of Gould, CO.

Directions:

For those of you who use GPS Locations, there are two ways to pinpoint our Campsite Location: Go to Google Maps and locate Gould, CO. Directly south of Gould, along Jackson County Road 21/Forest Roads 740/760 you will find a pin which reads "Old EFC of Eaton Campsite." That Pin marks the location. The exact GPS Coordinates, which will also get you there, are -- 40 degrees, 27 min, 45 sec, North by 106 degrees, 0 min, 36 sec, West.

For those of you who prefer road directions: Take Hwy. 14 west out of Ault, through Fort Collins (where it joins Hwy. 287 to Laramie) to where Hwy 14 splits from Hwy 287 at Ted's Place. (a mile or two after the La Porte Road - U.S. Bus 287 rejoins Hwys14/287) Continue on Hwy 14 west towards Walden. After you summit Cameron Pass, the first town you will encounter is Gould, CO. At Gould turn south/left on Jackson County Road 21 (which is also U.S. Forest Service Road 740) and continue along this road for 5-6 miles. You will pass Aspen & Pines Campgrounds, and several intersecting roads (792/21H, 791/21C, 789, 780, 770) along the way. Do not turn off of JCR21/FR 740 until you come to the Forest Service Road "y" where FR 760 & FR 740 split. (This is right after FR 770 diverges to the left) Take FR 760 for another few hundred yards till you come to our Campsite. We will have signs, along the way, beginning as you left turn off of Hwy 14 at Gould.)

The cost is \$45/person (5 yrs and under are free), and you can pay online or at the Info Desk on Sundays. Medical Releases (Required!), Packing & Equipment Info, and Directions will be available Online and at the Info Desk. **MEDICAL RELEASES MUST BE TURNED IN BEFORE TRIP.**
