



Week 1

Day 1: God Made Everything

Scripture Reading: Genesis ch 1

Devotional:

Before anything existed—before the sun, the animals, or even time itself—God was already there. Genesis 1 tells us that God created the whole world just by speaking. When God said, “Let there be light,” light appeared! When He spoke again, the sky, land, oceans, plants, and animals were made. God didn’t make the world by accident. He didn’t guess or hope it would work. He knew exactly what He was doing, and everything He made was good. That shows us that God is powerful, wise, and real. Think about how carefully the world is made. The sun gives us light and warmth. Plants grow from tiny seeds. Animals know how to find food. All of that works together because God designed it that way. A world this amazing didn’t just happen on its own—it was made by God. Every time you see something beautiful or amazing in nature, it can remind you: God is real, and He made this. God is real because He made the world. He is wise and powerful. He made the world we see (including you!) and He said that it was good!

Discussion:

1. What part of God’s creation makes you say “wow”?
2. What is your favorite thing about how God made you?

Prayer:

God, thank You for making the world with such care and power. When I see creation, help me remember that You are real. Amen.

Day 2: God Made People Special

Scripture Reading: Genesis ch 2

Devotional:

Genesis 2 shows us that people are different from everything else God made. God didn’t just speak people into existence—He carefully formed Adam and breathed life into him. This shows that God made people in a very special way. God gave people hearts to love, minds to think, and the ability to make choices. He wanted people to know Him, talk with Him, and enjoy the world He created. That means you were not made by mistake. God knows you, loves you, and wanted YOU to be here. Because God made people on purpose, He also cares about how we feel and what we go through. When you’re happy, God cares. When you’re sad or scared, God cares. A God who loves people like that is a real God. God didn’t create us to be His robots; He gave us the ability to make our own decisions. After sin entered the world it is easy for us to want to make the wrong decisions but God wants us to choose Him. He desires a close relationship with us. He cares deeply about you & He loves you so much!

Discussion:

1. What is something special God gave people that shows His love?
2. How can you choose God this week?

Prayer:

God, thank You for making me and loving me. Help me remember that I matter to You because You are real and care about me. Thank You for giving me the ability to choose You. I love You! Amen.



Day 3: Creation Shows God is Real

Scripture Reading: Romans 1:19-20

Devotional:

Romans 1 tells us something amazing: God has left clues about Himself in creation. That means when we look at the world, we can learn about God—even without hearing someone talk about Him. The huge oceans show how powerful God is. The tiny details of flowers and insects show how careful and creative He is. The stars in the sky remind us that God is bigger than anything we can imagine. All of creation quietly points to God and says, “He is real.” Just like footprints in the sand show that someone walked there, creation shows that God was here—and still is. God wants people to see the world and know that He made it and that He exists. When you learn about different animals or how many stars there are in the sky it is easy to believe that God made everything! He is so creative and He made things & creatures so intricately. What a miracle creation is!

Discussion:

1. What does creation tell you about God?
2. What is one of your favorite things God created and why?

Prayer:

God, thank You for showing Yourself through the world You made. Help me see You when I look at creation. You made everything with a purpose and I praise You and thank You for how You made everything. Amen.

Day 4: God Lasts Forever

Scripture Reading: Hebrews 1:10-12

Devotional:

Everything around us will someday wear out. Toys break. Clothes get old. Even the earth will one day change. But Hebrews tells us that God is different. He made the heavens and the earth, and He will last forever. God never gets tired, old, or weak. He is the same loving, powerful God today as He was when He created the world. That means we can always trust Him. No matter what changes in your life—school, friends, or feelings—God stays the same. Because God lasts forever, His love lasts forever too. A God who has always existed and will always exist is not pretend or imaginary. He is real, strong, and always with us. Isn't that a comforting thing to know? God never changes. Our lives change a lot as we grow up...we change ages, grades, schools, friends, and more. Having God as our steady and consistent friend is so important. When everything else changes...God does not.

Activity:

Creation Days Wheel

What to do: Make a circle divided into 7 sections. Draw or write what God created on each day. Decorate it with the different types of animals and plants that God made. This helps kids see that creation was planned and ordered—not random.

Prayer:

God, thank You for being the same forever. I'm thankful that I can trust You always. Amen.
