Day 1: God Was There From the Beginning

Scripture Reading: Genesis 1:1-2

Devotional:

Before there was anything—before the sky, the animals, or even time itself—God already existed. The Bible says, “In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.” That tells us God is powerful and eternal. He didn’t need anyone to make Him. He has always been God. Then we hear something very interesting: “The Spirit of God was hovering over the waters.” That means God’s Spirit was there too, moving and ready to create. Later in the Bible, we learn that Jesus was also part of creation. So even at the very beginning, we see that God was never alone. God is one God, but He exists as three

Persons: God the Father, God the Son (Jesus) & God the Holy Spirit. They are not three gods. They are one God who works perfectly together. They think together, love together, and act together. From the very start of the world, God showed us that He is Three in One.

That means God has always been loving, always been in relationship, and always been working for good.

Discussion:

1. What do you think it would be like to watch God create the world?
2. How does knowing that God is 3 in 1 make you feel?

Prayer:

God, You were there at the beginning, and You are with me now. Thank You for being so big and so loving. Amen.



Welcome to Week 2 of our Mystery Manor Devo! This week we will be learning about how God is 3 in 1. The Trinity! This truth is very hard to understand. Knowing that God is bigger and greater than we can even understand is somewhat comforting though. He takes such good care of us and He knows our needs even better than we do ourselves.

Day 2: Made to Reflect a 3 in 1 God

Scripture Reading: Genesis 1:26-27

Devotional:

When God created people, He said something very special: “Let us make humans in our image.” God didn’t say “me.” He said us. That helps us see again that God is Three in One—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—working together. Being made in God’s image doesn’t mean we look like God on the outside. It means we are made to be like Him on the inside. We can love others, make good choices, help people, and care about what is right and wrong. Each part of God helps us live this way:

1. God the Father loves us and made us on purpose
2. Jesus the Son shows us how to love by His life
3. The Holy Spirit helps us choose what’s right every day

You are not an accident. You were made carefully by a God who is loving, creative, and good—and you were made to show others what He is like.

Discussion:

1. What is one way you can show God’s love today?
2. In what ways do you struggle to love others?

Prayer:

God, thank You for making me special and for loving me. Help me show Your love to others. You have created me in Your image...help me to act like You and do what is right in every situation. We love You! Amen.

Day 3: God Sends His Son

Scripture Reading: Luke 1:26-38

Devotional:

God loved the world so much that He made a rescue plan. God the Father chose the perfect time to send Jesus, His Son, into the world. He sent an angel to Mary to tell her the amazing news. The angel explained that the Holy Spirit would come upon her and that her baby would be the Son of God. This was not just a normal baby—this was Jesus, God coming to live with people. Once again, we see the Trinity working together:

1. The Father planned the rescue
2. The Son came to earth
3. The Holy Spirit made the miracle happen

God didn't stay far away. He came close. He became a baby so we could know Him, trust Him, and be saved by Him. That's how much God loves us. Our sin separates us from God... but God made a way so we could come close to Him again because He loves us and wants a relationship with us!

Discussion:

1. Why do you think God chose for Jesus to come as a baby?
2. How does it feel knowing that God loves you enough to do what He did by sending Jesus?

Prayer:

Thank You, God, for sending Jesus to show us Your love. Help me trust You like Mary did.
Amen.

Day 4: God is with Us Every Day

Scripture Reading: John 14:26

Devotional:

Before Jesus went back to heaven, He told His friends something comforting. He said that God the Father would send the Holy Spirit to help them. The Holy Spirit would teach them and remind them of everything Jesus had said. Even though we can't see the Holy Spirit, He is real and active. He helps us understand the Bible, reminds us to be kind, and helps us make good choices. When we feel scared or confused, the Holy Spirit is with us. That means God is never far away:

1. The Father watches over us
2. Jesus saves us and loves us
3. The Holy Spirit lives with us and helps us

God is Three in One, and He is always working for our good. He knows all things and He wants the best for us!

Activity:

Decorate and color a piece of paper and write Biblical affirmations on them (feel free to ask an adult for help). For example:
"God made me in His image"
"God loves me"
"I can show God's love to others"
"I am beautifully & wonderfully made"

Prayer:

God, thank You for always being with me. Help me listen to the Holy Spirit today. Amen.
