Caring Connections Ministry...Holy Connections

Our Christian faith goes beyond simply believing in God and the gospel message. It's leaning into being a vessel for holy connections to occur through us. It's cultivating a holy awareness of and tenderness for the needs of others and then being willing to act as those needs arise. As James 2:14-17 teaches, it's not merely enough to use words; we must put our faith into action. It's a willingness to be inconvenienced, to step out of our comfort zone, to be selfless with our time, finances and talents, to be a cheerful giver and to recognize that Christ left His ministry to be carried out by our hands.



The Caring Connections Ministry is a vessel to extend Christ's love to women struggling with barriers of poverty in our community. We offer hope and support to those who are vulnerable and in need. We carry some of their burdens and help guide them in finding solutions. When the body of Christ, which is you and me, respond to meet the needs of lives, families and communities, our world is changed for the better. This is the gospel in action, occurring through acts of service. Recently, our ministry has been a bridge for holy connections to lift those we serve through the assistance of our churches and individuals. Below are just a few examples of how these needs were met:

- A women's group sponsored children's birthdays by providing a birthday bag filled with party decorations, party favors, themed plates/napkins, ingredients to make a cake, candles and a small gift.
- A ladies' group hosted a virtual baby shower to provide a new mom with everything she needed to welcome her new baby home, lifting a financial burden and stressor.
- A small family with limited, affordable housing options moved into a home that required significant cleaning and repairs. A gentleman, hearing of this need, immediately offered to rent a dumpster for a week so this family could throw away trash, moldy furniture, and old carpet left behind by a previous renter. Two men bought and installed a new door, a new lock and repaired the door frame so the family could feel safe. Others donated money to help cover partial costs of any additional repairs (flooring, water heater, and window air units).
- Three women trained to become mentors to come alongside a woman in need, offering encouragement, problem-solving, and places to be loved and supported.

Finally, a beautiful example of community...One of the moms served by our ministry was having health issues with her pregnancy due to her diabetes. Unexpectedly, she was admitted to the hospital for 48 hours to have her sugar levels managed. She did not know one person that she trusted to care for her seven-year-old daughter. Staff and a volunteer stepped up to care for her daughter as two days turned into six. This little girl had a safe place to be loved, cared for, and protected, and her mom could feel confident knowing her daughter was being loved.

This is the gospel – the small acts of service that carry on the ministry of Jesus to a hurting world.
