## What Do You Dwell On?

James Clear, author of the immensely popular and helpful *Atomic Habits*, starts his weekly newsletter this way:

*Don't ruminate, activate.*

*I find it is difficult to think my way into a better mood. When I sit and stew, the problem usually grows larger in my mind.*

What do you ruminate (dwell on, fixate on, “stew” over) about in your idle moments? Something bad is currently happening? Happened in the past? About to maybe happen?

I am reminded once again of Paul’s encouragement to the Philippians and to us . . .

*Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things. Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me or seen in me—put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you.* Philippians 4:8-9

Not a *quick thought* about whatever is true, noble, etc. But rather, *dwell on* these things.

This is not an excuse to throw caution to the wind or have a “whatever” attitude. There are some serious things happening in our brothers’ and sisters’ lives and in our world. But, there are also a lot of good things happening.

This is a caution to dwell on the good things, not to ignore the evil things, but to always hope for the redemptive things. Dwell on these things. Easy? Nope! Helpful? Absolutely!~ Harvey
