## Job the Encourager

Eliphaz the Temanite was the first friend to speak to Job, after they had commiserated seven days in silence with him. Eliphaz spoke this to Job, then went on to condemn him in the middle of his suffering. As the old saying goes, “With friends like these . . .”

But what he originally said about Job was the truth. Job had influenced and encouraged many in his life. Eliphaz says this . . .

*Think how you have instructed many, how you have strengthened feeble hands. Your words have supported those who stumbled; you have strengthened faltering knees. ~ Job 4:3-4*

Job had been an encourager! Makes me think about us. How often do we encourage others?

Not in an attempt to “one up” them, “Yeah, you think you’ve got it bad, why I remember . . .”

Not in an attempt to “admonish” them, as Eliphaz did: “You did well, but maybe this has come upon you because you . . .”

But to truly say, “I’m so sorry. I can only imagine your hurt.” Or “You do well. I’m proud of you.” Even if you offer nothing but prayer (and who minimizes that?), you can at least offer empathy, sympathy, or silence.

God has placed encouragers among us as a spiritual gift, not just in hard times, but also in good. As Paul says, *so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us. If your gift is prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your faith; if it is serving, then serve; if it is teaching, then teach; if it is to encourage, then give encouragement; if it is giving, then give generously; if it is to lead, do it diligently; if it is to show mercy, do it cheerfully.*

~ Romans 5:5-8

Encouragement is sorely needed by everyone. Give it generously, freely, without expectation of any in return. God wants and equips encouragers. Try it today. Someone you know is needing encouragement!
