## Job's Then and Now

*Oh, for the days when I was in my prime, when God's intimate friendship blessed my house, when the Almighty was still with me and my children were around me, when my path was drenched with cream and the rock poured out for me streams of olive oil.*

~ Job 29:2-6

The story of Job is made bearable because we know the back story (chapters 1-2). But I still don't get it. Why does God allow Job to suffer like that at Satan's hands? Doesn't God care?

Job expresses his anguish in a long, torturous discourse of how he was treated "then," and "now" (chapters 29-30). It's REALLY sad.

In his discourse he says, in essence, "I really wish the good ol' days were here, when God was with me, looked over me, was a friend to me. And now – He has deserted me."

But God had a LOT of confidence in Job. After all, it was God Who threw out the challenge to Satan: *Have you considered my servant Job? There is no one on earth like him; he is blameless and upright, a man who fears God and shuns evil.*

Our life at times is an echo of Job's life. Things are going great! Our paths are drenched with cream and rocks pour out streams of olive oil (ease, wealth and goodness.) And then "it" happens.

Does that mean God has deserted us? That He doesn't care? That we've lost His favor. Hardly!

God intently listened to Job and his "friends," and I believe He intently watches over us, even when it seems like He has deserted us.

When you suffer (and you will), you may think it's because you did something bad, that God doesn't care, that you're not all you should be.

Remember, Job didn't suffer because he was bad, but because he was good. Stay faithful. Persevere. As hard as it may be at times, remember, *If God is for us, who can be against us?*
