What Can Church Members Do for Their Shepherds?

Some time ago, I watched Greg Clark present a sermon titled “What the Congregation Needs to Do for Elders.” In the sermon, he listed five things that members say to their elders.

Those five were: I pray for you, I pray for your wife, I have confidence in you, I need to talk to you, and I thank you.

Do we tell our shepherds that we pray for them and their wives? When we pray for them, sometimes we need to pray for them specifically by name and not as a group. Do we tell our shepherds that we support them and have confidence in their leadership?

Due to confidentiality, our shepherds make decisions with information they have but cannot and should not share with members. If a member has a question about a decision the elders have made, let them know that you want to talk to them about it in a Biblical way.

All of us like to be recognized and thanked for our service. Please find ways to thank our shepherds.

One other thing Greg mentioned in his sermon that was very interesting and appreciated by the elders was when a group of members showed up before an elders’ meeting to pray for them and thank them for their service.
