Bad News on the Doorstep

Yeah, I know most of you don't remember the song *American Pie*. It came out in 1971, so it's ancient. (Wow, I'm feeling bad now; need to sit down for a minute.)

Maybe you heard your parents or grandparents singing it. It (supposedly) pays homage to Buddy Holly (yeah, you don't remember him either. Neither do I.)

But even if you don't remember the song, some of the lyrics still touch our spirits at certain times, one of which goes like this . . .

But February made me shiver / With every paper I'd deliver

Bad news on the doorstep / I couldn't take one more step

We've had a lot of difficult news this last month (and February made us shiver!). But in the midst of often overwhelming events, please take some comfort in these thoughts and passages, as do I.

Remember that some are celebrating great victories, so let's not "rain on their parade." Instead, as Paul says, "*Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn.*" (Romans 12:15)

Remember to both receive and give comfort to each other, again as Paul says, "*Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves receive from God.*" (2 Corinthians 1:3-4)

Remember to be aware that God knows and cares what we're going through, even though He may not always answer prayers as we would like. "*Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? Yet not one of them will fall to the ground outside your Father's care. And even the very hairs of your head are all numbered. So don't be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows.*" (Matthew 10:29-31)

Remember that you are loved and that a church family is praying for you. *And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people.* (Ephesians 6:18)

May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all. (2 Corinthians 13:14)
