Why Study Leviticus?

I'm fascinated with Leviticus - well, sort of. It's filled with arcane rules and regulations (what's up with all the skin disease stuff?). And those sacrifices? What gives with all that?

So I did what I would not have done several years ago (because it wasn't available). I thought I would ask AI (ChatGPT), what the purpose in studying Leviticus was. I was surprised at the answer. For a machine, it did pretty well.

Here are some of its insights (edited for length):

Leviticus holds significant value for Christians for several reasons:

- 1. Understanding God's Holiness*
- 2. Foreshadowing Jesus Christ*
- 3. God's Desire for Relationship*
- 4. A Model for Ethical Living*
- 5. A Deeper Appreciation for Grace*

Not bad, is it? I'm ambivalent about AI. It can get some things wrong, but it can also be helpful. It should be (must be), accompanied by other study. Here it's pretty helpful in focusing our attention to probably one of the least read books in the Bible.

At least two things to remember about Scripture. First, some of the great jewels of the Bible are buried deep. Remember that the second greatest commandment is found in Leviticus: *"Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength."* **The second is this: "Love your neighbor as yourself."** (Leviticus 19:18) *There is no commandment greater than these.*" ~ Mark 12:30-31

Second, we do well to remember that the things written in the past were written *for us*. As Paul says, *"For everything that was written in the past was written to teach us, so that through the endurance taught in the Scriptures and the encouragement they provide we might have hope."* ~ Romans 15:4

Even if you don't read Leviticus regularly (and who does?), remember that it's there for our learning as well as the other books of the Bible. Any and every book of the Bible is good to read. Now, pardon me while I turn my attention to the Psalms!
