When I was growing up, I attended church camp each first or second week in August at Camp Frame in Hedgesville, WV. Each night at 8:00, we would meet at the Point for what we called our Vesper Service. We sat outside where there was a steep drop off on the left and a narrow trail on the right that led a good way down to Back Creek.

As the sun would set during the service on the Blue Ridge Mountains, I was always in awe of God's creation. On the stone podium were the words, "I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills." When things aren't going well for me or when I am in the process of making major decisions, I reflect back to those August evenings and Psalm 121.

Where are your places or memories of tranquility when you feel or felt close to God and knew that He was and is in control, that He loved and loves you, and that He has never and will never leave you?
