Fresh Faith at the Margins of Routine: Part 2

Summer gives us margins. Empty afternoons, flexible evenings, the long golden stretch of twilight. These unscheduled spaces can become sacred ones—if we let them.

In *Every Moment Holy*, Douglas McKelvey reminds us that every action—folding laundry, sipping coffee, watching a storm—can become a liturgy. Brother Lawrence found deep connection with God not in sermons, but in scrubbing pans. Patrick of Ireland wandered with God into wild hills and foreign lands and taught people to pray in each of these spaces. None of them waited for a “perfect” space. They *chose* to make holy whatever space they happened to occupy.

So what are you taking with you this summer? A short prayer? A favorite psalm? A small notebook to capture gratitude or breath prayers on the go? What’s on your nightstand? Maybe a printed routine for mornings or a candle you light when you need peace.

This isn’t about rigid habits. It’s about **invitations**. Every unhurried moment is an open door. Invite God in. Not just to Sunday. Not just to big plans. But to your moments—ordinary and unshaped.

Holiness can fill your hammock, your walk, and your waiting room. Make a new space for God.
