The Woman

She stood at Jesus' feet crying. Then she began to wash his feet with her tears. She dried his feet with her hair. She kissed his feet many times and rubbed them with the perfume. Luke 7:38

Simon the Pharisee. An unnamed woman "who had lived a sinful life." He is looked up to. She is looked down on. He is a church leader. She is a streetwalker. He makes living standards. She's made a living breaking them. He's hosting the party. She's crashing it. Whom did Jesus choose to honor that day?

Why did He choose her? She came thirsty. Thirsty from guilt. Thirsty from regret. Thirsty from countless nights of trying to find love her way and finding. None. She came thirsty. She came broken.

I knew a woman like that as well. That night in 1998 when she realized what the Savior's Love and Grace meant to her. She had been thirsty for forgiveness for twenty years--Yet could not forgive herself. So that night her heart heard Him speak to her heart saying, "Child I love you. You have been forgiven. Accept my Grace. Forgive yourself."

She didn't sip from that cup. She turned it up and gulped the contents to quench the thirst for her dry parched soul. She fell at the feet of her Savior and covered those nail scared feet with an overwhelming flood of thankful tears. She found and accepted the Grace that had always been there.

She lived the rest of her life loving others deeply. We can't give what we've never received. If we've never received grace, how can we give grace to others?
