Fresh Faith at the Margins of Routine: Part 1

I want to share some reflections for the next three weeks relative to the changing of seasons, the end of a school year, and the beginning of summer. In Acts 24, Governor Felix listens to Paul speak about faith, righteousness, and the coming judgment—but replies, “When I have a convenient time, I will summon you.” It’s a haunting phrase. We’ve all delayed what matters, waiting for that elusive “convenient season.”

But here’s a question for you: **What if the shift in your schedule *is* your convenient season?**

Summer brings unpredictable rhythms—no school drop-offs, later bedtimes, different work patterns. And while that might feel chaotic, it’s also an opportunity. A spiritual door might open now that has stayed closed in April.

Do you have more mornings free? Less evening pressure? Is your heart a little less hurried? Use this window. Pick up a devotional. Start a daily walk with prayer or a new podcast. Visit a neighbor. The gospel doesn’t wait for the stars to align. It simply asks: ***What can you do today?***

A new rhythm doesn’t have to feel disruptive. It can be holy. God is already here—waiting—not when it’s convenient, but when it’s **now**.
