New Adult Sunday School Classes – Two new Sunday School classes have begun:

Who Shall Ascend the Mountain of the Lord? – In this study, we will consider the overarching theology of the book of Leviticus, uncovering the ways that the book emphasizes God's holiness, the way that we must approach Him, and the way that the Old Testament foreshadows Christ's work.

The English Reformation and the Puritans – In this 12-part series, Dr. Michael Reeves surveys Puritan theology and the work of the Holy Spirit when the Reformation flourished in England.
