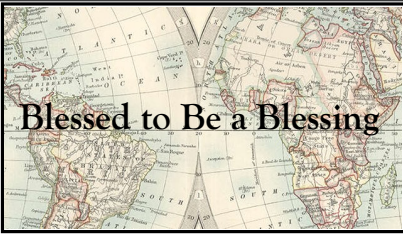
Also, we are still in need for people to host our missionaries for a meal during the conference. Please sign up to host a missionary by using the sheet on the welcome table in the narthex.
