Speaker: Victor Nakah



Victor and Nosizo met in college and are products of the Christian student ministry movement. They were richly impacted by the ministries of Scripture Union in high school and International Fellowship of Evangelical Students in college. Victor later served with both organizations for several years and was instrumental in establishing Christian student groups in universities in southern Zimbabwe.

Victor is an ordained Presbyterian minister and has served in various capacities in the church and related organizations. His most recent position was with CURE International, where he served as senior vice president for spiritual ministry. Before joining CURE, he served as the Africa regional director for Overseas Council International. He was also a seminary president for 10 years in Zimbabwe. During this time, he earned a master's degree in systematic theology from the University of South Africa and a Ph.D. in systematic theology from Stellenbosch University.

In addition to his primary ministry as MTW international director for Sub-Saharan Africa, Victor supervises master's and Ph.D. students attending South Africa Theological Seminary, teaches at the Africa Reformation Theological Seminary (Uganda), and is Extraordinary Researcher for North-West University.

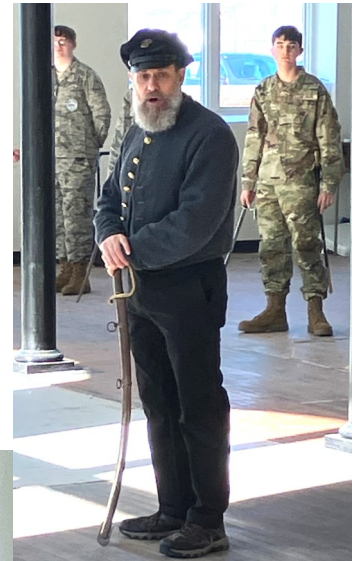
Navigator and Adventurers, after attending Swordfest, spent a very cold night camping at Congaree National Park.

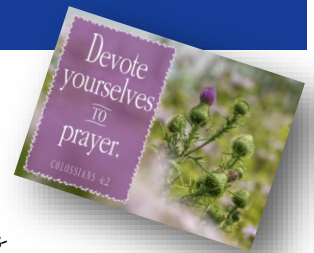

## Book Review

### *Evangelism and the Sovereignty of God*

by J.I. Packer (Review)

When it comes to sharing our faith, most of us are filled with anxiety. Will the person reject Christ? Will I share the message effectively? Did I share my faith enough? Was I a worthy witness for Christ?

In his classic book, *Evangelism and the Sovereignty of God*, J.I. Packer unpacks the age-old tension between God's sovereignty and human responsibility as it relates to evangelism. Many times, opponents of Reformed theology will say, "If God is sovereign, there is no point in your evangelism." Packer tells us why this is a misguided thought. God is completely sovereign, yet the church has the responsibility to evangelize.

Even more, Packer reminds us that it is precisely because God is sovereign that we may have confidence in our evangelism. If God was not capable of using our meager efforts to save His people, then we would have no basis to share the good news. But if God can (and does) use His people's flimsy attempts at evangelism to draw his church to Himself, then we may evangelize with all confidence—not in ourselves but in the God who made heaven and earth.

If you are discouraged in evangelism, if you have found yourself slothful in your efforts to share Christ, if you are lacking confidence in your own abilities, then this book is for you. Pick it up, read it and be amazed at the God who saves!
