Sermon Text

Now a certain man was ill, Lazarus of Bethany, the village of Mary and her sister Martha. ²It was Mary who anointed the Lord with ointment and wiped his feet with her hair, whose brother Lazarus was ill. ³So the sisters sent to him, saying, "Lord, he whom you love is ill." ⁴But when Jesus heard it he said, "This illness does not lead to death. It is for the glory of God, so that the Son of God may be glorified through it."

⁵Now Jesus loved Martha and her sister and Lazarus. ⁶So, when he heard that Lazarus was ill, he stayed two days longer in the place where he was. ⁷Then after this he said to the disciples, "Let us go to Judea again." ⁸The disciples said to him, "Rabbi, the Jews were just now seeking to stone you, and are you going there again?" ⁹Jesus answered, "Are there not twelve hours in the day? If anyone walks in the day, he does not stumble, because he sees the light of this world. ¹⁰But if anyone walks in the night, he stumbles, because the light is not in him." ¹¹After saying these things, he said to them, "Our friend Lazarus has fallen asleep, but I go to awaken him." ¹²The disciples said to him, "Lord, if he has fallen asleep, he will recover." ¹³Now Jesus had spoken of his death, but they thought that he meant taking rest in sleep. ¹⁴Then Jesus told them plainly, "Lazarus has died, ¹⁵and for your sake I am glad that I was not there, so that you may believe. But let us go to him." ¹⁶So Thomas, called the Twin, said to his fellow disciples, "Let us also go, that we may die with him."

⁵Or, Jésus aimait Marthe, sa sœur et Lazare. ⁶Lorsqu'il apprit que Lazare était malade, il resta encore deux jours dans le lieu où il était. ⁷Après cela, il dit aux disciples : « Retournons en Judée. » ⁸Les disciples lui dirent : Rabbi, il y a peu de temps les Juifs cherchaient à te lapider, et tu retournes là-bas ? ⁹Jésus leur répondit : N'y a-t-il pas douze heures au jour ? Si quelqu'un marche pendant le jour, il ne trébuche pas, parce qu'il voit la lumière de ce monde. ¹⁰Mais si quelqu'un marche pendant la nuit, il trébuche, parce que la lumière n'est pas en lui. ¹¹Après avoir dit cela, il leur dit : Lazare, notre ami, s'est endormi, mais je vais le réveiller. ¹²Les disciples lui dirent : Seigneur, s'il s'est endormi, il guérira. ¹³Or, Jésus avait parlé de sa mort, mais ils pensèrent qu'il voulait dire qu'il se reposait dans le sommeil. ¹⁴Alors Jésus leur dit ouvertement : Lazare est mort. ¹⁵Et à cause de vous, je me réjouis de ce que je n'étais pas là, afin que vous croyiez. Mais allons vers lui. ¹⁶16 Thomas, appelé Jumeau, dit alors aux autres disciples : Allons-y, nous aussi, afin de mourir avec lui.

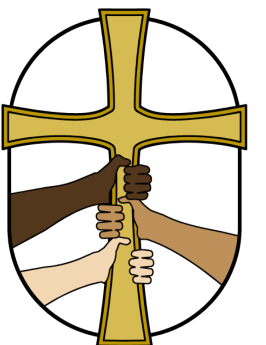

Tutoring begins January 21

Firm Foundation Tutoring, a ministry of New City, is in need of at least 10 more volunteer tutors because a number of fall tutors have had schedule changes and we would also love to welcome new kids to the program.

Tutors come to the Hodiamont office OR New City South building each week for 1.5 hours during one of the following sessions and typically work one-on-one with the same student all 14-15 weeks of the semester:

Mondays | 5- 6:30 p.m. OR 5:30-7:00 p.m.

Wednesdays | 5- 6:30 p.m. OR 5:30-7:00 p.m.

Tuesdays | 4- 5:30 p.m. OR 4:30- 6:00 p.m.

Thursdays | 4- 5:30 p.m. OR 4:30- 6:00 p.m.

Tutors will receive training and support to equip them in their role (no prior experience needed).
