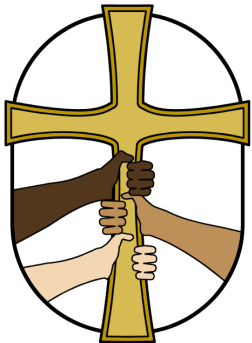

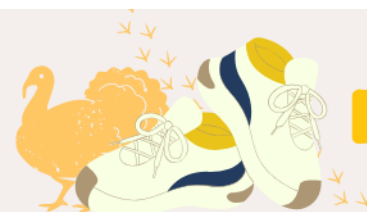

Wiggle ROOM
