The Wiggle Room is located in the Northwest corner of the gym and is a multipurpose space for various New City families and ministries. Additionally, a room is available for nursing moms up the stairs in the foyer and to the far end of the hallway as you turn left. There is a speaker to allow you to listen to the sermon, as well as complimentary snacks and water.
