

John 9: 35-41



Become a Tutor this Fall

[Firm Foundation Tutoring](#), a ministry of NCF-UC and Restore St. Louis, is seeking 10 additional volunteer tutors this fall. Because we have a 1:1 ratio for tutors and kids, your involvement helps welcome a kid! Tutors come to the Hodimont building *once a week* and typically work with the same student all semester.



Mondays | 5:30 to 7:00 p.m.

Tuesdays | 4:00 to 5:30 p.m.

Wednesdays | 5:30 to 7:00 p.m.

Thursdays | 4:00 to 5:30 p.m.

Tutors will receive training and support to equip them (no prior experience needed). Substitute tutors are also needed, if you are not able to make a semester-long commitment.

Wiggle ROOM

The Wiggle Room is located in the Northwest corner of the gym and is a multipurpose space for various New City families and ministries. Families are welcome to use the play area during the service for babies and little wiggler. We ask that you clean up when you leave, and please do not leave your children unattended. Additionally, a room is available for nursing moms up the stairs in the foyer and to the far end of the hallway as you turn left. There is a speaker to allow you to listen to the sermon, as well as complimentary snacks and water.

Babies & PRESCHOOL

During the church service sermon time, we provide care, Bible teaching, and songs for babies, toddlers, and preschoolers in the nursery rooms up the stairs by the foyer. During the break in the worship service, parents can sign in their children at the desk in front of the nursery and sign them out after communion. Blast AND BLAST 9

BLAST is our program for kids ages Kindergarten through 5th grade. It includes BLAST 9: small group Bible teaching and projects from 9-10am, as well as big group activities during the sermon.
