Open:

- What is your natural default when someone you love is in need? (i.e. do you bring a meal, call them, help financially?)
- What about when you are in need? (i.e. do you ask for help? Hide?)

Discussion Questions:

- Were you able to attend service or watch the LiveStream? What were some take-aways?
- Together, read Mark 1:40-45. When you read this in Luke 5:12, it says he was covered with leprosy. This man was in his final stages as the disease had taken over his body. Why does the man with leprosy come to Jesus? Was he hopeful? Desperate?
- In the NIV, verse 41 says, "Jesus was *indignant*". Some versions say, "Jesus was moved with compassion", or "Moved with pity". What does it say about Jesus that He took the time and heard this man's request?
- It was against Jewish ceremonial law to touch a leper. This act was radical. Why do you think Jesus touched the man instead of just speaking healing over him?
- What else does this reveal about the character of God?
- As soon as Jesus touched the leper, he was healed. What do we know we need from Jesus?
- Do you believe God is willing to heal you?
