WEEK 4: God is Grace

Open:

- What was a high point from the week/ weekend?
- What is your go-to hobby or activity on a rainy day?

Discussion Questions:

- Together, read Mark 2:13-17. Is there anything new or noteworthy in the section of text? Did anything stand out specifically?
- Jesus says, "I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners". What does this tell us about God's heart and priorities?
- Levi was a tax collector. In that day, tax collectors were seen as somewhat of traders or extortioners. What does this passage teach us about who Jesus extends grace to? How does that challenge common assumptions about who "belongs" in church?
- The people who followed Jesus, whether they believed Him or not, seemed to have a lot of opinions about Him. How do you think about Jesus? (i.e. As a good teacher? A higher being to vent to? Constantly? Sometimes?).
- When Jesus chose His disciples, He did not try to conform Himself to other people's opinions, but rather aligned Himself with God's mission. Do you struggle with peer pressure, even when it doesn't align with the Lord?
- The Pharisees focused on who was "worthy". How do we sometimes slip into performance-based thinking instead of grace-based living? How does this affect how we view ourselves, others or God?
- Levi's response to grace was to host a dinner and invite others. How does receiving grace naturally lead to extending grace? Is that true in your own life?
