Dear Fellow Servant,

I am writing this letter as Pastor of the co-sending Church of Missionaries Benji and Kerri Dryden. I have known the Dryden family for nearly thirty years, dating back to Bro. Don and Mrs. Bridgitt Dryden, Bro. Benji's parents. They are of the highest caliber of Christian Missionaries.

Due to circumstances beyond their control with the civil unrest in Haiti, and by the recommendation of the Haitian Church leaders, Bro. Benji and Mrs. Kerri had to leave the country. Shortly after Bro Benji returned to the States his father became debilitatingly ill. Bro. After much prayer and counsel, Bro. Benji and Mrs. Kerri believe this is the direction the Lord would have them to go in. This will allow them to continue their life's work in Haiti and to expand their ministry throughout the entire Caribbean.

I and Grace Baptist church are excited for the Dryden's and what the future holds for them as they follow God's will and pursue this exciting opportunity.

I urge all of the Dryden's supporters to continue to support them with your financial gifts and prayers as they expand their ministry to include all of the Caribbean. We believe the Dryden's will do a tremendous job in this expanded responsibility.
