

We tried our best to prepare our kids for things that are different in this culture such as, "Remember, toilet paper goes in the toilet in the states, NOT in the trash can like in Brazil." But, despite our efforts, we found ourselves in the customs line in Florida with Abby commenting, "Wow, a lot of people speak English here!" Apparently we had forgotten to mention that. But, the transition back has gone smoothly overall. We enjoyed a couple of weeks right away with both of our families, including a vacation with my parents and others. This was such a sweet time, a little reprieve from the flurry of activity that Home Assignment generally is. Since then, we picked up a leased minivan from Righteous Rides ministries and began our road trip from Florida to West Virginia in the wake of a winter storm. The Lord brought us here safely, and we've been loving time with our church family. We had a commissioning service to officially "Send us" to the X people, and we have been making the most of the opportunities to catch up with friends. We will make a very quick trip to WI and MO at the end of March, and then go back to FL in April, at which point we will be resting and preparing for our move back to Brazil in May.



Back "Home"
