In mid-March, I was finalizing some logistics for our trip to Wisconsin the following week. In particular we were planning to share at a supporting church that we'd never met in person before. So, I reached out to the pastor, whom I also had never met, to work out some details of our visit. Shortly thereafter I received a call by someone else in the church informing me that the pastor of the church had passed away very suddenly a couple days earlier and was with the Lord. However, the church still wanted us to visit, despite it being the same weekend as the pastor's funeral, and it ended up being a sweet weekend together. However, these events were a striking reminder to us of our frailty as humans. But none of this should discourage us as Christians or make us worried, but rather compel us to live wisely (Ps. 90:12, Eph. 5:15-16) and be faithful with every breath God gives us to declare His praise.

## Our hearts' plan and God's direction

One verse that continues to be a theme for us recently is Prov. 16:9 — "A man's heart plans his way, But the LORD directs his steps." For those who don't know, our plan has been to be in the states until early May, move to Manaus, Brazil, and live in the city until building our house in the tribe somewhere around September. First of all, our return date has moved to the beginning of June so that we can be part of Spencer's cousin's wedding. And what's more, in a surprising turn of events, we are now happy to announce that we will not be moving to the tribe as a family of five like we'd thought! That's right! Baby #4 is due October 8th! Needless to say, this does affect our plans for house building and moving into the tribe. We may have to wait until after the birth of the baby to begin construction of our house. We are still in the process of adjusting our plans, but we are so thankful that God has worked out many of the details already! First of all, we now have a place to stay lined up in Manaus for when we get back. We will be living at the Puraquequara International School on the banks of the Amazon River from June-July and then at our mission base from August-October, at least. Spencer will be helping with a dorm renovation project at the International School and also preparing logistics for our own house building. Also, a close friend of ours has graciously agreed to come and live with us for several weeks in Sept.-Oct. in order to help us with our kids when our baby is born. This is a huge answer to prayer!
